Adapes/Passages is a non profit organization which promotes international discussions on a range of subjects, including sustainable development, through the organizations of meetings and conferences and through the publication of a journal. Its activities are supported by the French Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs but are non-governmental and designed to promote dialogue between relevant parties.

Adapes/Passages has held activities over the years in which leading Israeli representatives have participated. It is not a political organization but creates forums for discussions and contacts.
